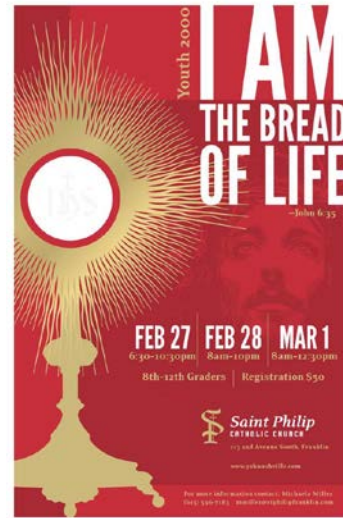
GIRLS SODALITY
