LEGION OF MARY

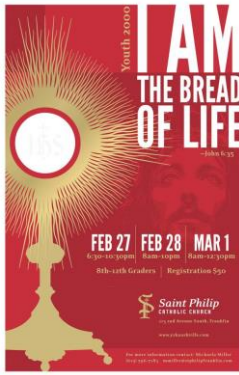

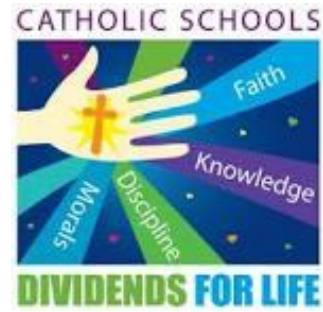
