## GOOD FRIDAY FAST & ABSTINENCE

The law of the Church obligates Catholics in good health and between the ages of 18 and 60 to fast on Good Friday. In addition all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from eating meat on Good Friday. **FASTING** means partaking of only one full meal during the day. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at breakfast and around midday or in the evening, depending on when a person chooses to eat the main or full meal. **ABSTINENCE** forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products or condiments made of animal fat.

## DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

Beginning on **April 3**, following the Good Friday Liturgy, the novena and chaplet of Divine Mercy will be recited in the chapel and will continue in the home of the participants for nine days. This devotion will conclude with a celebration on the **Octave of Easter, April 12**, at **3:00 p.m.** in the chapel.
