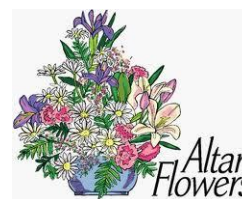
#### **JUNIOR BOYS' SERVICE LEAGUE**
