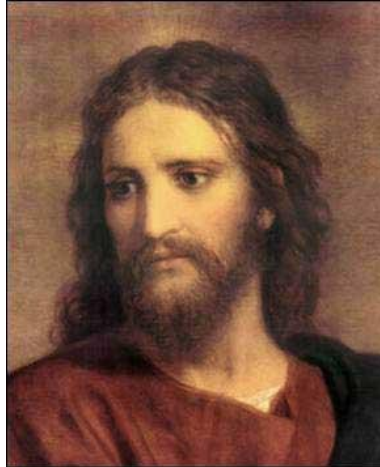

Forty Hours Devotion

Saint John Vianney Parish will be holding a Forty Hours Devotion on Wednesday, May 25, Thursday, May 26, Friday, May 27, and Saturday, May 28, in preparation for the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the annual celebration of the Catholic Church in thanksgiving for the gift of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. This devotion developed in the 16th century in Italy and offers the opportunity to spend time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament for the Church and the world. The forty hours represent the time Christ's body spent in the tomb. Participation in Eucharistic Adoration is a worthy response to Christ's interrogation of his disciples in the Garden of Gethsemane, "Could you not watch with me one hour?"

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for Adoration on Wednesday and Friday, from 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m., on Thursday from 12:00 noon until 9:00 p.m., and on Saturday from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.
