Stations of the Cross will be held in the chapel each Friday of Lent at **7:00 p.m.**

LENTEN RULES require Catholics between the ages of 18 and 60 to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In addition all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent.

FASTING as explained by the U.S. Conference of Bishops means partaking of only one full meal during the day. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at breakfast and around midday or in the evening, depending on when a person chooses to eat the main or full meal.

ABSTINENCE forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products, or condiments made of animal fat.

LENTEN PRETZELS

On Wednesday, the third grade class at St. John Vianney School made and sold pretzels to the students and teachers during snack time. The proceeds from the sale supported the Catholic Charities Refugee Department.

Pretzels were developed as an option to satisfy abstinence and fasting laws of the time. Eggs, fat, and milk were forbidden during Lent. The shape reminds us of praying arms. In fact, the word pretzel comes from a Latin word meaning folded arms.
