“You are the best mother ever. I am going to crown you at my house”.

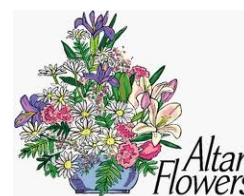
“Thank you for loving me, caring for me, and watching over me. Thank you for giving birth to Jesus. I love you very much”.

This devotion developed in the 16<sup>th</sup> century in Italy and offers the opportunity to spend time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament for the Church and the world. The forty hours represent the time Christ's body spent in the tomb. Participation in Eucharistic Adoration is a worthy response to Christ's interrogation of his disciples in the Garden of Gethsemane, "Could you not watch with me one hour?"*
