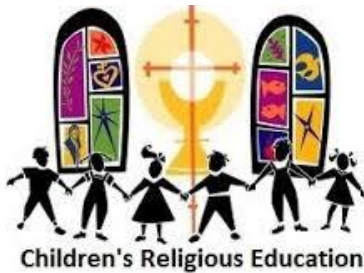


**The Sunday Rosary Group** invites everyone to join them each **Sunday following the 10:30 a.m. Mass** to pray a Scriptural Rosary.
