FORENSICS TOURNAMENT WINNER

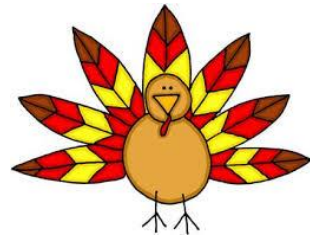
