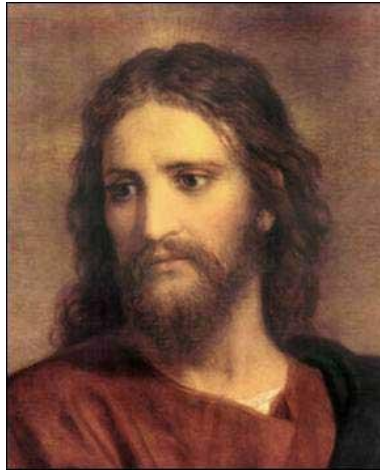

SENIOR BOYS' SERVICE LEAGUE

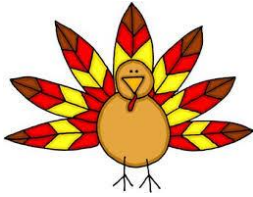
