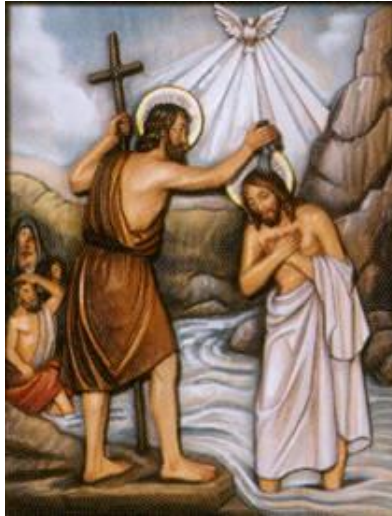

Fr. Gideon's Bible Study Class will resume this **Monday, January 16, 2017**, at **9:00 a.m.** in the parish office building.

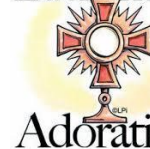
