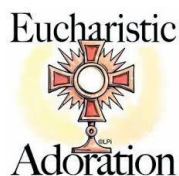
## PARISH OFFICE

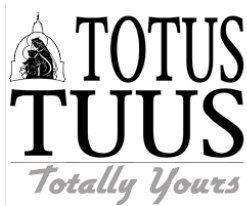
