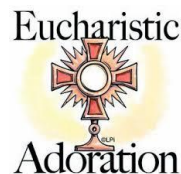

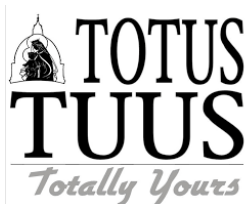


Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is held each **Saturday following the 8:00 a.m. Mass**, closing with **Benediction at 4:00 p.m.**
